20	1. Joanne Wenzel (Complainant) brings	s this Statement of Issues solely in her official	
21	capacity as the Chief of the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education, Department of		
22	Consumer Affairs.		
23	2. On or about November 1, 1987, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education		
24	(Bureau) issued Full Approval to Operate Institution Code Number 1917381 to Alexander		
25	Training Institute of Los Angeles (Respondent and/or the Institution). Said Full Approval expired		
26	on February 28, 2013, and has not been renewed.

- 3. On or about March 11, 2016, the Bureau received an "Application for a Verification of Exempt Status, Application # 29083" (Application) from Alexander Training Institute of Los Angeles (Respondent).
- 4. On or about March 10, 2016, Lyn Charlsen Klein certified under penalty of perjury to the truthfulness of all statements, answers, and representations in the application. The Bureau denied the Application on March 21, 2016.

JURISDICTION/STATUTORY PROVISIONS

- 5. This Statement of Issues is brought before the Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs (Director) for the Bureau, under the authority of the Act [California Education Code, Title 3, Division 10, Part 59, Chapter 8 "Private Postsecondary Institutions," section 94800 et seq.], including the following laws. All section references are to the Education Code (Code) unless otherwise indicated.
 - 6. Code section 94827 states:

"Continuing education" means instruction in subjects that licensees are required to take solely for the purpose of continued licensure, or to enhance their skills and knowledge within their particular profession, occupation, trade, or career field.

7. Code section 94843 states:

"Institution" means any private postsecondary educational institution, including its branch campuses and satellite locations.

8. Code section 94847 states:

"License and examination preparation" means instruction designed to assist students to prepare for an examination for licensure. "License and examination preparation" does not include an educational program designed to instruct students in the skills and knowledge necessary to satisfy the qualifications for licensure.

9. Code section 94848 states:

"Licensure" includes any license, certificate, permit, or similar credential that a person must hold to lawfully engage in a profession, occupation, trade, or career field.

2	"Postsecondary education" means a formal institutional educational	
3	program whose curriculum is designed primarily for students who have completed or terminated their secondary education or are beyond the compulsory age of secondary education, including programs whose purpose is academic, vocational, or continuing professional education.

6	"Private postsecondary educational institution" means a private entity	
7	with a physical presence in this state that offers postsecondary education to the public for an institutional charge.

26	admissions for each educational program and those standards are related to the particular educational program.	
27	(3) The facilities, instructional equipment, and materials are sufficient to	
28	enable students to achieve the educational program's goals.	

- b. In response to question 3 in Respondent's Application, "Identify the basis for the exemption(s) to which the entity is entitled, and provide the required information," Respondent's President, Part Owner and Member of the Board of Directors certified under penalty of perjury that Respondent was "An institution offering continuing education or license examination preparation . . ."
- c. On March 21, 2016, the Bureau notified Respondent that it was denying its request for an exemption, because the Institution did not demonstrate that it met the qualifications for exemption from regulations under Code section 94874, subdivision (d)(2). The Bureau's decision was based on the analysis that the Institution does not solely provide continuing education or license examination preparation programs. Although the Institution offers a program to certified Alexander Technique teachers, which consists of seminars and post-graduate studies to refresh their skills on the technique, this is the only program that appears to be continuing education. The Institution provides a six-week Provisional Interval Program and a Three-Year Teacher Training Course to educate students on the Alexander Technique. The three-year program will lead to certification as a teacher of the Alexander Technique. In addition, it appears that the Institution's programs are available to the general public, and not solely offered to licensed teachers.

PRAYER

WHEREFORE, Complainant requests that a hearing be held on the matters herein alleged, and that following the hearing, the Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs issue a decision:
