21	IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGR	EED by and between the parties to the above-		
22	entitled proceedings that the following matters are true:			
23	PARTIES			
24	1. Deborah Cochrane (Complainant) is the Chief of the Bureau for Private			
25	Postsecondary Education (Bureau). Leeza Rifredi was Acting Chief of the Bureau when			
26	Accusation No. 1006499 was filed and served, and brought the Accusation in her official capacity			
27	as Acting Chief of the Bureau. Complainant is represented in this matter by Rob Bonta, Attorney			
28	General of the State of California, by Julianne Mossler, Deputy Attorney General.			
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1	2. College of Botanical Healing Arts (Respondent) represents itself in this proceeding		
2	and has chosen not to exercise its right to be represented by counsel.		
3	3. On or about January 8, 2001, the Bureau issued Approval to Operate Institution Code		
4	Number 4400871 to Respondent. The Approval to Operate was in full force and effect at all		
5	times relevant to the charges brought in this Accusation No. 1006499, and will expire on May 14,		
6	2024, unless renewed.		
7	JURISDICTION		
8	4. Accusation No. 1006499 was filed before the Director of the Department of		
9	Consumer Affairs (Director), and is currently pending against Respondent. The Accusation and		
10	all other statutorily required documents were properly served on Respondent on April 9, 2021 and		
11	April 13, 2021. Respondent timely filed its Notice of Defense contesting the Accusation. A copy		
12	of Accusation No. 1006499 is attached as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference.		
13	ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS		
14	5. Respondent has carefully read, and understands the charges and allegations in		
15	Accusation No. 1006499. Respondent also has carefully read, and understands the effects of this		
16	Stipulated Surrender of Approval to Operate and Order.		
17	6. Respondent is fully aware of its legal rights in this matter, including the right to a		
18	hearing on the charges and allegations in the Accusation; the right to be represented by counsel at		
19	its own expense; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against it; the right to		
20	present evidence and to testify on its own behalf; the right to the issuance of subpoenas to compel		
21	the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents; the right to reconsideration and		
22	court review of an adverse decision; and all other rights accorded by the California		
23	Administrative Procedure Act and other applicable laws.		
24	7. Respondent voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waives and gives up each and		
25	every right set forth above.		
26	<u>CULPABILITY</u>		
27	8. Respondent admits the truth of each and every charge and allegation in Accusation		
28	No. 1006499, agrees that cause exists for discipline and hereby surrenders its Approval to		

Operate Institution Code Number 4400871 for the Bureau's formal acceptance.

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9. Respondent understands that by signing this stipulation Entity enables the Director to issue an order accepting the surrender of it Approval to Operate Institution Code Number
4400871 without further process.

CONTINGENCY

This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Director or the Director's 6 10. designee. Respondent understands and agrees that counsel for Complainant and the staff of the 7 8 Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education may communicate directly with the Director and 9 staff regarding this stipulation and surrender, without notice to or participation by Respondent. 10 By signing the stipulation, Respondent understands and agrees that it may not withdraw its agreement or seek to rescind the stipulation prior to the time the Director considers and acts upon 11 12 it. If the Director fails to adopt this stipulation as the Decision and Order, the Stipulated 13 Surrender and Disciplinary Order shall be of no force or effect, except for this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in any legal action between the parties, and the Director shall not be disqualified 14 from further action by having considered this matter. 15

16 11. The parties understand and agree that Portable Document Format (PDF) and facsimile
17 copies of this Stipulated Surrender of Approval to Operate and Order, including PDF and
18 facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the originals.

19 12. This Stipulated Surrender of Approval to Operate and Order is intended by the parties
20 to be an integrated writing representing the complete, final, and exclusive embodiment of their
21 agreement. It supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings,
22 discussions, negotiations, and commitments (written or oral). This Stipulated Surrender of
23 Approval to Operate and Order may not be altered, amended, modified, supplemented, or
24 otherwise changed except by a writing executed by an authorized representative of each of the
25 parties.

13. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that
the Director may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following
Order:

1	<u>ORDER</u>		
2	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Approval to Operate Institution Code Number 4400871,		
3	issued to Respondent College of Botanical Healing Arts, is surrendered and accepted by the		
4	Bureau.		
5	1. The surrender of Respondent's Approval to Operate Institution Code Number		
6	4400871 and the acceptance of the surrendered Approval to Operate by the Bureau shall		
7	constitute the imposition of discipline against Respondent. This stipulation constitutes a record of		
8	the discipline and shall become a part of Respondent's Approval to Operate history with the		
9	Bureau.		
10	2. Respondent shall lose all rights and privileges as a Private Post-Secondary Institution		
11	in California as of the effective date of the Director's Decision and Order.		
12	3. If Respondent ever files an application for an Approval to Operate in the State of		
13	California, the Bureau shall treat it as a new application. Respondent must comply with all the		
14	laws, regulations and procedures for approval in effect at the time the application is filed, and all		
15	of the charges and allegations contained in Accusation No. 1006499 shall be deemed to be true,		
16	correct and admitted by Respondent when the Director determines whether to grant or deny the		
17	application.		
18	4. Respondent shall pay the Bureau the costs of investigation and enforcement in this		
19	matter in the amount of \$6,016.25 prior to issuance of any new Approval to Operate.		
20	5. The acceptance of the Stipulated Surrender of Approval to Operate an Accredited		
21	Institution shall not preclude the filing of any civil claims against Respondent related to the		
22	allegations in Accusation No. 1006499.
