Christina Villanueva issues this Citation: Assessment of Fine and Order of Abatement (Citation) in her official capacity as Discipline Manager of the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) of the California Department of Consumer Affairs.

CITATION

A Citation is hereby issued to International Christian Education College, Owner of International Christian Education College (Institution) located at 3807 Wilshire Boulevard, Suite 730, Los Angeles, CA 90010, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.9; California Education Code (CEC) sections 94936 and 94932; and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations (5, CCR) section 75020 for the violations described below.

BACKGROUND

On September 13, 2019, Bureau staff attempted to conduct an unannounced Compliance inspection at the Institution. Upon arrival, there was no one present at the Institution and the front door was locked. The Institution failed to have personnel available during the Institution's posted business hours of Monday through Thursday 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., and Friday 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., in violation of 5, CCR section 71930(e).

On September 13, 2019, at approximately 9:15 a.m., Bureau staff attempted to conduct an unannounced Compliance inspection at the Institution. Upon arrival, Bureau staff attempted to call the Institution's representative whose business card was attached to the front door. Bureau staff was unable to reach the representative and was unable to reach any other Institution representatives as the Institution's main line number rang without answer. The Institution failed to have personnel available during the Institution's posted business hours of Monday through Thursday 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., and Friday 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., in violation of 5, CCR section 71930(e).

Order of Abatement:

The Bureau orders the Institution to submit a written policy of how future compliance will be maintained per 5, CCR Section 71930.

Assessment of Fine

The fine for this violation is <u>\$5,000.00</u>

ASSESSMENT OF A FINE

In accordance with CEC section 94936; and 5, CCR sections 75020 and 75030, the Bureau hereby orders this assessment of fine in the amount of **\$5,000.00** for the violations described above. **Payment must be made, to the Bureau, within** <u>**30 days**</u> from the date of service of the Citation.

COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER OF ABATEMENT

In accordance with the provisions of CEC section 94936 and 5, CCR section 75020 the Bureau hereby issues the order(s) of abatement described above. **Evidence of compliance with the order(s) of abatement must be submitted, to the Bureau, within** <u>30 days</u> from the date of service of the Citation.

APPEAL OF CITATION

You have the right to contest this Citation through an informal conference with the Bureau; and/or through an administrative hearing in accordance with Chapter 5 (Commencing with Section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code.

If you wish to contest this Citation, you must submit the 'Notice of Appeal of Citation – Request for Informal Conference and/or Administrative Hearing' form (enclosed) within <u>30 days</u> from the date of service of the Citation. *If you do not request an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing within 30 days from the service of the Citation, you will not be able to request one at a later time.*

Unless a written request for an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing is signed by you and delivered to the Bureau by **April 1, 2020**, you will be deemed to have waived or forfeited your right to appeal this matter.

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EFFECTIVE DATE OF CITATION

If you do not request an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing, this Citation shall become effective on **March 2, 2020**. Payment of the administrative fine and evidence of compliance with the order(s) of abatement shall be due by **April 1, 2020**. Your payment of the administrative fine shall not constitute an admission of the violation(s) charged.

If a hearing is requested, you will not be required to comply with this Citation until 30 days after a final order is entered against you.
