Christina Villanueva issues this Citation: Assessment of Fine and Order of Abatement (Citation) in her official capacity as Discipline Manager of the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) of the California Department of Consumer Affairs.

CITATION

A Citation is hereby issued Azizkhon Yuldoshonov, Owner of ProMED Career Institute (Institution) located at 5300 Santa Monica Blvd., Ste 415, Los Angeles, CA 90029, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.9; California Education Code (CEC) sections 94936 and 94932; and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations (5, CCR) section 75020 for the violations described below.

BACKGROUND

Prior to an announced Compliance Inspection on December 19, 2019, Bureau staff found that the Institution advertises on its website the following programs without Bureau approval: NCLEX-RN Review, ECG& Pharmacology, and CNA. The Institution is offering the courses through "Zero-Max Institute," an exempt institution, but are advertising the courses as their own.

VIOLATIONS

#	Below you will find the California Education Code (CEC) and/or Title 5 of the California Code of
	Regulations (5, CCR code) section(s) of law you are charged with violating.

1. **Violation:**

CEC Section 94893. Authorization Required for Substantive Change

"If an institution intends to make a substantive change to its approval to operate, the institution shall receive prior authorization from the bureau. Except as provided in subdivision (a) of Section 94896,

if the institution makes the substantive change without prior bureau authorization, the institution's approval to operate may be suspended or revoked."

CEC Section 94894. Substantive Change Defined

"The following changes to an approval to operate are considered substantive changes and require prior authorization:

- (a) A change in educational objectives, including an addition of new diploma or degree educational program unrelated to the approved educational programs offered by the institution.
- (b) A change in ownership.
- (c) A change in control.
- (d) A change in business organization form.
- (e) A change of location.
- (f) A change of name.
- (g) A significant change in the method of instructional delivery.
- (h) An addition of a separate branch more than five miles from the main or branch campus."

The Institution failed to obtain Bureau approval prior to advertising NCLEX-RN Review, ECG & Pharmacology, and CNA courses on their website. The Institution is offering courses through an exempt institution, Zero-Max Institute, and is advertising the courses as their own.

Order of Abatement:

The Bureau orders that the Institution notify the Bureau of any substantive changes by submitting the appropriate Change of Educational Objective Application to the Bureau. The Institution shall not advertise, as well as discontinue advertising, programs to students not approved by the Bureau, per CEC section 94893.

Assessment of Fine

The fine for this violation is \$501.00

ASSESSMENT OF A FINE

In accordance with CEC section 94936; and 5, CCR sections 75020 and 75030, the Bureau hereby orders this assessment of fine in the amount of \$501.00 for the violations described above. Payment must be made, to the Bureau, within 30 days from the date of service of the Citation.

COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER OF ABATEMENT

In accordance with the provisions of CEC section 94936 and 5, CCR section 75020 the Bureau hereby issues the order(s) of abatement described above. **Evidence of compliance with the order(s) of abatement must be submitted, to the Bureau, within 30 days** from the date of service of the Citation.

APPEAL OF CITATION

You have the right to contest this Citation through an informal conference with the Bureau; and/or through an administrative hearing in accordance with Chapter 5 (Commencing with Section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code.

If you wish to contest this Citation, you must submit the 'Notice of Appeal of Citation – Request for Informal Conference and/or Administrative Hearing' form (enclosed) within <u>30 days</u> from the date of service of the Citation. If you do not request an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing within 30 days from the service of the Citation, you will not be able to request one at a later time.

Unless a written request for an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing is signed by you and delivered to the Bureau by **September 12**, **2020**, you will be deemed to have waived or forfeited your right to appeal this matter.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF CITATION

If you do not request an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing, this Citation shall become effective on **August 13**, **2020**. Payment of the administrative fine and evidence of compliance with the order(s) of abatement shall be due by **September 12**, **2020**. Your payment of the administrative fine shall not constitute an admission of the violation(s) charged.

If a hearing is requested, you will not be required to comply with this Citation until 30 days after a final order is entered against you.
