On September 8, 2022, an informal telephone conference was held in the matter of Citation: Assessment of Fine and Order of Abatement No. 2223010 (Citation) against Computer Technologies Program, Owner of Computer Technologies Program (Institution). In attendance were Daniel Rangel, Enforcement Chief, Christine Tabony, Business Manager, and Alex Tabony, Executive Director.

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code, section 125.9; California Education Code, section 94936; and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations, section 75020 and section 75040, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) renders the following decision relative to your appeal of the Citation No. 2223010.

It is the decision of the Enforcement Chief that on October 3, 2022, Citation No. 2223010 is <u>modified</u> and makes the following change(s):

and was unable to inspect records during normal business hours in accordance with CEC Section 94932.5 and 5, CCR Section 71930.

Order of Abatement:

The Bureau orders the Institution to submit a written policy, or procedure, of how future compliance will be maintained in accordance with CEC Section 94932.5 and 5, CCR Section 71930.

Fine Amount: \$5,000.00

<u>Reason for modification</u>: New substantive facts were presented at the conference.

The administrative fine for this violation has been modified from \$5,000.00 to \$1,000.00.TOTAL MODIFIED ADMINISTRATIVE FINE DUE: \$1,000.00\$1,000.00

ORDER OF ABATEMENT

The Bureau orders that you comply with the orders described in the 'Violation Code Sections' of this document and submit evidence of compliance within <u>30 days</u> from the date of this decision.

APPEAL OF CITATION

You *do not* have the right to request another Informal Conference to appeal this modified Citation. If you did not initially request an Administrative Hearing within 30 days from when the original citation was issued, you can no longer request one.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF CITATION AND FINE ASSESSMENT

This modified Citation is effective on **October 13, 2022**. The Order of Abatement and payment are due by **November 12, 2022**.

Failure to abate the violation or to pay the administrative fine within the time allowed is grounds for denial of an application for an approval to operate or discipline. The Bureau will promptly take all appropriate action to enforce the Modified Citation and recover the civil penalties prescribed therein or found to be due after a hearing.
