21	1. Leeza Rifredi (Complainant) brings	this Statement of Issues solely in her official	
22	capacity as the Deputy Chief of the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education, Department of		
23	Consumer Affairs.		
24	2. On or about May 17, 2013, the Bure	au for Private Postsecondary Education received	
25	an Application for Renewal of Approval to Operate an Institution Non-Accredited from Career		
26	Advancement Solutions (Respondent). On or about May 8, 2013, Virgilio Abad certified under		
27	penalty of perjury to the truthfulness of all statements, answers, and representations in the		
28	application. Between June 6, 2013 and August 1	19, 2016, the Bureau and Respondent exchanged	

correspondence regarding its application. On or about July 8, 2016, the Bureau issued a deficiency letter to Respondent. On or about August 19, 2016, the Bureau received a response to its July 8, 2016 letter.

3. On or about September 9, 2016, the Bureau issued Respondent a Notice of Denial of Application for Renewal of Approval to Operate. On or about September 20, 2016, the Bureau received a request for an administrative hearing from Respondent. On or about May 16, 2017, Respondent submitted additional documents in support of its application to the Bureau.

## **JURISDICTION**

- 4. This Statement of Issues is brought before the Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs (Director) for the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education, under the authority of the following laws. All section references are to the Education Code unless otherwise indicated.
  - 5. Section 94886 provides:

"Except as exempted in Article 4 (commencing with Section 94874) or in compliance with the transition provisions in Article 2 (commencing with Section 94802), a person shall not open, conduct, or do business as a private postsecondary educational institution in this state without obtaining an approval to operate under this chapter."

6. Section 94887 provides:

"An approval to operate shall be granted only after an applicant has presented sufficient evidence to the bureau, and the bureau has independently verified the information provided by the applicant through site visits or other methods deemed appropriate by the bureau, that the applicant has the capacity to satisfy the minimum operating standards. The bureau shall deny an application for an approval to operate if the application does not satisfy those standards."

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"(b) To be granted a renewal of an approval to operate, the institution shall demonstrate its continued capacity to meet the minimum operating standards."

8. Section 94910 provides:

Section 94891 provides, in part:

"Except as provided in subdivision (d) of Section 94909 and Section 94910.5, prior to enrollment, an institution shall provide a prospective student with a School Performance Fact Sheet containing, at a minimum, the following information, as it relates to the educational program:

"(c) License examination passage rates for programs leading to employment for which passage of a state licensing examination is required, as calculated pursuant to Article 16 (commencing with Section 94928).

9. California Code of Regulations, title 5, section 71700 states:

"The Bureau may request that an institution document compliance with the standards set forth in the Act and this Division to obtain and maintain an approval to operate."

- 10. California Code of Regulations, title 5, section 74112 states:
- "(a) Format. The format for the Performance Fact Sheet shall be in at least 12 pt. type, in an easily readable font, with 1.15 line spacing and all titles and column headings shall be in bold 14 pt. type, which shall also identify the program for which the Performance Fact Sheet pertains. The Performance Fact Sheet shall contain all and only the information required or specifically permitted by sections 94910 and 94929.5 of the Code or this chapter. A separate Performance Fact Sheet shall be prepared for each program.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> The California Private Postsecondary Education Act of 2009 was recently amended, effective January 1, 2017. *See* Senate Bill No. 1192. This Statement of Issues is based on the post-amendment version of the Act.

- "(i) Job Placement Rates.
- (1) Any placement data required by sections 94910(b) and 94929.5(a) of the Code shall be reported for the number of students who began the program as defined in subdivision (d)(1) of this section for each reported calendar year.
- (2) Placement is measured six months from the graduation date of each student. For programs that require passage of a licensing examination, placement shall be measured six months after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program. Reporting of placement rates shall include for each educational program: the number of students who began the program, the number of graduates as defined in section 94842 of the Code, the graduates available for employment, graduates employed in the field and job placement rate(s).
- (3) If the institution makes any claim related to preparing students for a job or regarding job placement, the list required by section 94910(f)(2) of the Code shall identify the employment positions by using the Detailed Occupation or six-digit level of the Standard Occupational Classification codes.
- (4) Placement rate shall be calculated as follows: the number of graduates employed in the field as defined in section 94928(e)(1) of the Code in conjunction with section 74112(d)(3) divided by the number of graduates available for employment as defined in section 94928(d) of the Code.

Job Placement rates and related disclosures shall be included in the Performance Fact Sheet in a format substantially similar to the charts below, (dates, numbers, and other data shown are for

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example only):

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'Students Available for Graduation' is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.

'Number of On-time Graduates' is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.

'On-time Completion Rate' is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.

'150% Graduates' is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).

'150% Completion Rate' is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.

'Graduates Available for Employment' means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.

'Graduates Unavailable for Employment' means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.

'Graduates Employed in the Field' means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six month period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.

'Placement Rate Employed in the Field' is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.

'Number of Graduates Taking Exam' is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.

'First Available Exam Date' is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.

'Passage Rate' is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.

'Number Who Passed First Available Exam' is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.

'Salary' is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.

'No Salary Information Reported' is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.

"(n) The institution shall provide on a separate document along with the Performance Fact Sheet the same cancellation disclosure as that which is required to be included with the enrollment agreement by Section 94911(e)(1) of the Code. The separate document shall be substantially the same size as the Performance Fact Sheet and shall be captioned 'STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL' using bold 14 pt. type."

## CAUSE FOR DENIAL OF APPLICATION

(School Performance Fact Sheet)
(Ed. Code, § 94910, subd. (c); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 5, § 74112, subd. (a), (d)(1), (d)(2), (f), (g), (h), (i), (l), (n).)

- 11. Respondent's application is subject to denial because its School Performance Fact Sheet fails to comply with the law on the following grounds:
- a. Respondent did not submit a School Performance Fact Sheet in the correct format. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 5, § 74112, subd. (a).).
- b. Respondent did not provide a School Performance Fact Sheet that includes the correct definition for "Number of Students Who Began Program." (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 5, § 74112, subd. (d)(1).).
- c. Respondent did not provide a School Performance Fact Sheet that includes the correct definition for "Number of On-time Graduates." (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 5, § 74112, subd. (d)(2).).

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- d. Respondent did not provide a School Performance Fact Sheet that includes the required "Cost of Educational Program" information. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 5, § 74112, subd. (f).).
- e. Respondent did not provide a School Performance Fact Sheet that includes verbiage regarding a 3-year cohort default rate that is compliant. The School Performance Fact Sheet did not include the Federal Student Loan Debt table or the applicable statement if the institution does not participate in federal financial aide programs and the line for Student Initials and Date. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 5, § 74112, subd. (g).).
- f. Respondent did not provide a School Performance Fact Sheet that uses the correct heading for the On-Time Completion Rate (Graduation Rate) table. The School Performance Fact Sheet also does not include the required columns, "Number of On-Time Graduates" and "On-Time Completion Rate" as part of the On-Time Completion Rate table. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 5, § 74112, subd. (h).).
- g. Respondent did not provide a School Performance Fact Sheet that includes a correctly formatted Placement Table. The School Performance Fact Sheet does not include any of the required Gainful Employment Categories tables. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 5, § 74112, subd. (i).).
- h. Respondent did not provide a School Performance Fact Sheet that includes the correct definition for "On-Time Completion Rate," "150% Graduates," "150% Completion Rate," "Graduates Employed in the Field," "Placement Rate Employed in the Field," "Salary," and "No Salary Information Reported." (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 5, § 74112, subd. (l).).
- i. Respondent did not provide a School Performance Fact Sheet that includes, on a separate document along with the Performance Fact Sheet, the same cancellation disclosure as that which is required to be included with the enrollment agreement by Section 94911, subdivision (e)(1) of the Code. The separate document shall be substantially the same size as the Performance Fact Sheet and shall be captioned "STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL" using bold 14 pt. type. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 5, § 74112, subd. (n).).
