§94897 - Prohibited Business Practices.	(1) Use the terms "approval," "approved," "approval to operate," or	
	"approved to operate" without stating clearly and conspicuously

	set forth in this chapter. If the bureau has granted an institution

	The institution's catalog failed to include a complete statement and included Education Codes from the Bureau for Private	

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Post-Secondary and Vocational Education. To remedy this violation the institution shall revise their catalog including the complete required statement: (see example) This institution is a private institution approved to operate by the California Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education. Approval to operate means the institution is compliant with the minimum standards contained in the California Private Postsecondary Education Act of 2009 (as amended) and Division 7.5 of Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations. In addition, the institution shall send an email to all current California students informing them of the revised version of the catalog with a hyperlink to where the revised catalog can be found on the institution's website. The institution's catalog failed to include this as a verbatim statement. Additional language was added to the statement and an incorrect mailing address for the bureau provided. To remedy the violation the institution shall remove any additional language from this verbatim statement and correct the bureau's contact information. In addition, the institution shall send an email to all current California students informing them of the revised version of the catalog with a hyperlink to where the revised catalog can be found on the institution's website. A copy of the e-mail sent to students and revised catalog shall be submitted with the institution's response to the NTC and the last page of this document within the specified time frame. §94909 - Minimum Requirements for (a)(6) If the educational program is designed to lead to positions in School Catalog. a profession, occupation, trade, or career field requiring licensure in this state, a notice to that effect and a list of the requirements for eligibility for licensure. The institution's catalog failed to include the specific

state.

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To remedy the violation the inscitution shall add a complete list of all requirements for licensure in this state. In addition, the institution shall send an email to all current California students informing them of the revised version of the catalog with a hyperlink to where the revised catalog can be found on the institution's website. A copy of the e-mail sent to students and revised catalog shall be submitted with the institution's response to the NTC and the last page of this document within the specified time frame. §94909 - Minimum Requirements for (a)(7) Information regarding the faculty and their qualifications. School Catalog. The institution's catalog failed to include a complete list of faculty and their qualifications. To remedy the violation the institution shall include a complete list of instructors and their qualifications. In addition, the institution shall send an email to all current California students informing them of the revised version of the catalog with a hyperlink to where the revised catalog can be found on the institution's website. A copy of the e-mail sent to students and revised catalog shall be submitted with the institution's response to the NTC and the last page of this document within the specified time frame. §94909 - Minimum Requirements for (a)(8) A detailed description of institutional policies in the School Catalog. following areas: (A) Admissions policies, including the institution's policies regarding the acceptance of credits earned at other institutions or through challenge examinations and achievement tests, admissions requirements for ability-to-benefit students, and a list describing any transfer or articulation agreements between the institution and any other college or university that provides for the transfer of credits earned in the program of instruction. If the institution has not entered into an articulation or transfer agreement with any other college or university, the institution shall disclose that fact. The institution's admissions policy references an ATB test being used for admissions. The catalog shall include the ATB test being accepted and the passing scores. The institution's catalog also failed to include a statement indicating whether the institution accepts transfer credits from other schools and if the school has entered into a transfer or articulation agreement with any other schools. In order to remedy the violation, the institution shall include

all required disclosures listed above.

In addition, the institution shall send an email to all current

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California students informing tnem of the revised version of the catalog with a hyperlink to where the revised catalog can be found on the institution's website. A copy of the e-mail sent to students and revised catalog shall be submitted with the institution's response to the NTC and the last page of this document within the specified time frame. §94909 - Minimum Requirements for (B) Cancellation, withdrawal, and refund policies, including an School Catalog. explanation that the student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment. whichever is later. The text shall also include a description of the procedures that a student is required to follow to cancel the enrollment agreement or withdraw from the institution and obtain a refund consistent with the requirements of Article 13 (commencing with Section 94919). The institutions catalog failed to include a statement including an explanation that the student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. To remedy the violation the institution shall revise their catalog to include the required cancelation policy. In addition, the institution shall send an email to all current California students informing them of the revised version of the catalog with a hyperlink to where the revised catalog can be found on the institution's website. A copy of the e-mail sent to students and revised catalog shall be submitted with the institution's response to the NTC and the last page of this document within the specified time frame. §94909 - Minimum Requirements for (a)(9) The schedule of total charges for a period of attendance and School Catalog. an estimated schedule of total charges for the entire educational program. The institution's catalog failed to contain a statement for the total charges for a period of attendance and total charges for entire program. To remedy the violation the institution shall add the total charges for a period of attendance and total charges for entire program. In addition the institution needs to add STRF fees as \$0 (non-refundable) In addition, the institution shall send an email to all current California students informing them of the revised version of the catalog with a hyperlink to where the revised catalog can be found on the institution's website.

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	A copy of the e-mail sent to students and revised catalog shall be submitted with the institution's response to the NTC and the last page of this document within the specified time frame.
§94909 - Minimum Requirements for School Catalog.	(a)(11) A statement specifying that, if a student obtains a loan to pay for an educational program, the student will have the responsibility to repay the full amount of the loan plus interest, less the amount of any refund, and that, if the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of the moneys not paid from federal student financial aid program funds.
	The institution's catalog failed to include a statement specifying if a student obtains a loan to pay for an educational program the student will have the responsibility to repay the loan.
	To remedy the violation the institution shall add the required disclosure statement.
	In addition, the institution shall send an email to all current California students informing them of the revised version of the catalog with a hyperlink to where the revised catalog can be found on the institution's website.
	A copy of the e-mail sent to students and revised catalog shall be submitted with the institution's response to the NTC and the last page of this document within the specified time frame.
§94911 - Minimum Requirements for Enrollment Agreement.	An enrollment agreement shall include, at a minimum, all of the following: (h) The transferability disclosure that is required to be included in the school catalog, as specified in paragraph (15) of subdivision (a) of Section 94909. 94909(a)(15) The following statement: "NOTICE CONCERNING TRANSFERABILITY OF CREDITS AND CREDENTIALS EARNED AT OUR INSTITUTION
	The institution's enrollment agreement was missing the required verbatim title specified in in paragraph (15) of subdivision (a) of Section 94909.
	To remedy the violation the institution shall add the verbatim language to their enrollment agreement.
	Documentation of compliance shall be submitted with the institution's response to the NTC and the last page of this document within the specified time frame.
§94911 - Minimum Requirements for Enrollment Agreement.	(c) In underlined capital letters on the same page of the enrollment agreement in which the student's signature is required, the total charges for the current period of attendance, the estimated total charges for the entire educational program, and the total charges the student is obligated to pay upon enrollment.

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The institution's enrollment agreement failed to include the required statements noted above. To remedy the violation the institution shall update their enrollment agreement to include the total charges for the current period of attendance, the estimated total charges for the entire educational program, and the total charges the student is obligated to pay upon enrollment. Documentation of compliance shall be submitted with the institution's response to the NTC and the last page of this document within the specified time frame. §94911 - Minimum Requirements for (d) A clear and conspicuous statement that the enrollment Enrollment Agreement. agreement is legally binding when signed by the student and accepted by the institution. The institution's enrollment agreement failed to include a clear and conspicuous statement that the enrollment agreement is legally binding when signed by the student and accepted by the institution. To remedy the violation the institution shall update their enrollment agreement to state clearly and conspicuously the required disclosure. Documentation of compliance shall be submitted with the institution's response to the NTC and the last page of this document within the specified time frame. §94911 - Minimum Requirements for (e) (1) A disclosure with a clear and conspicuous caption. Enrollment Agreement. "STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL," under which it is explained that the student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. The institution's cancelation policy did not state that the student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. The institution had an alternate refund policy not approved by the bureau. To remedy the violation the institution shall update their enrollment agreement with the correct cancellation policy. Documentation of compliance shall be submitted with the institution's response to the NTC and the last page of this document within the specified time frame. §94900 - Required Student Records (b) An institution shall maintain, for each student granted a degree or certificate by that institution, permanent records of all of the following: (2) The courses and units on which the certificate or

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degree was based.(3) The grades earned by the student in each of those courses.

The institution's graduate files failed to contain transcripts that included the courses and units the certificate was based on and the grades earned by each student.

To remedy the violation the institution shall provide complete transcripts for three graduate files.

Documentation of compliance shall be submitted with the institution's response to the NTC and the last page of this document within the specified time frame.

A copy of the e-mail sent to students and revised catalog shall be submitted with the institution's response to the NTC and the last page of this document within the specified time frame. In addition, the institution shall send an email to all current California students informing them of the revised version of the catalog with a hyperlink to where the revised catalog can be found on the institution's website. A copy of the e-mail sent to students and revised catalog shall

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	be submitted with the institution's response to the NTC and the last page of this document within the specified time frame.

	The institution's catalog failed to include a statement in their grievance policy allowing students to contact the bureau to file a grievance prior to filing a grievance with the school.
