On May 29, 2020, an informal telephone conference was held in the matter of Citation: Assessment of Fine and Order of Abatement No. 1920275 (Citation) against Christopher Casey, Owner of Deep Creek Construction School (Institution). In attendance were Beth Danielson, Enforcement Chief, Douglas Smith, Department of Consumer Affairs Legal Counsel, and Christopher Casey, Owner.

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code, section 125.9; California Education Code, section 94936; and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations, section 75020 and section 75040, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) renders the following decision relative to your appeal of the Citation No. 1920275.

It is the decision of the Enforcement Chief that on May 29, 2020, Citation No. 1920275 is <u>affirmed</u> for the following reason(s):

➤ No new substantive facts were presented at the conference.

VIOLATION CODE SECTIONS

1. Violation:

CEC Section 94932.5(a) – Announced and Unannounced Compliance Inspections "(a)As part of its compliance program, the bureau shall perform announced and unannounced inspections of institutions at least every five years."

94935(a) - Notice to Comply

"(a) Bureau staff who, during an inspection of an institution, detect a violation of this chapter, or regulations adopted pursuant to this chapter, that is a minor violation as determined by the bureau, pursuant to regulations adopted by January 1, 2011, shall issue a notice to comply before leaving the institution."

On February 25, 2020, a Notice to Comply was not issued to Mr. Casey due to his interference with the inspection process and his inappropriate behavior. The Bureau is mandated to perform announced and unannounced inspections of each institution; however, Mr. Casey's behavior impeded the inspector from completing all phases of the inspection.

Assessment of Fine

The fine for this violation is \$5,000.00

ORDER OF ABATEMENT

The Bureau orders that you comply with the orders described in the 'Violation Code Sections' of this document and submit evidence of compliance within 30 days from the date of this decision.

APPEAL OF CITATION

You *do not* have the right to request another Informal Conference to appeal this affirmed Citation. You *do*, however, have the right to appeal this affirmed Citation through an Administrative Hearing. A hearing before an Administrative Law Judge will be scheduled and you will be notified of the hearing date. The hearing will be held pursuant to Chapter 5 (commencing with section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code.

If you do not wish to appeal this affirmed Citation you must withdraw your initial request for an Administrative Hearing, if one was made. Please complete and mail the enclosed <u>Withdrawal – Request for Administrative Hearing</u> within <u>30 Days</u> of the date of this decision.

You *do not* have the right to request another Informal Conference to appeal this affirmed Citation. If you did not initially request an Administrative Hearing within 30 days from when the original citation was issued, you can no longer request one.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF CITATION AND FINE ASSESSMENT

This affirmed Citation is effective on **July 9, 2020.** The order of abatement and payment are due by **August 8, 2020**.

Failure to abate the violation or to pay the administrative fine within the time allowed is grounds for denial of an application for an approval to operate or discipline. The Bureau will promptly take all appropriate action to enforce the Affirmed Citation and recover the civil penalties prescribed therein or found to be due after a hearing.
