To remedy this minor violation, MBEC shall provide the remainder of
the missing STRF substantiating data for the 3 rd quarter of 2022 and
advise the Bureau of MBEC's continuing plan to maintain the required
STRF substantiating data within thirty days of this Notice to Comply.
